Michelman's purpose is Innovating a Sustainable Future. We strive to conduct our operations consistent with this purpose by making the environment in which we live and work safer and more sustainable for all by improving the sustainability of our operations. We believe in this purpose because it is who we are, and what we have been committed to, since Michelman was founded in 1949. We incorporate sustainability into everything we do. This means creating products that will help improve the environment beyond our doors, by eliminating waste to landfill, reducing wastewater, and eliminating substances of concern while also reducing our own environmental footprint. Michelman has defined our Environmental Policy to complement our Global Environmental Health & Safety Policy.

In pursuit of this, we will comply with all applicable legal and regulatory requirements in the countries we operate in.

Michelman has set the following Environmental Sustainability goals as part our planet positive initiative.

By 2030, Michelman will

- Reduce energy consumption from fossil fuel sources by 50%*
- Reduce solid waste from our manufacturing operations by 50%*
- Eliminate wastewater discharge from our manufacturing operations

In addition, we make the following commitments:

- We will regularly and progressively evaluate our product portfolio for Substances of Concern (SOCs) and work to eliminate these from our products.
- We will continue to partner with customers and suppliers who are committed to advancing sustainability in the markets we serve.
- We will constantly seek input and information on human and environmental impacts, and adjust our portfolio accordingly.
- We will minimize our Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions. Michelman will invest to reduce energy consumption in our global sites.
- We will foster awareness of sustainability across our business operations and support our associates with decision making relevant to internal and external environmental issues.
- We will maintain accurate hazard classifications on our products and communicate these to our customers and other downstream stakeholders.

The progress of the above goals will be reported to our Board of Directors annually. It is the responsibility of the Global Director of Sustainability to engage appropriate resources to attain these goals and to ensure accurate and on-time reporting of results.
